The assessors would then come onto the ice and see if they had executed it each time on the same groove. If they hadn't, they would not pass their work. They didn't like it, infact it was a bore and frustrating to many, however, they knew it was the key to succeeding. If you only practice the stuff you like, the stuff you don't like will never get better and will pull you back. No one likes that.
